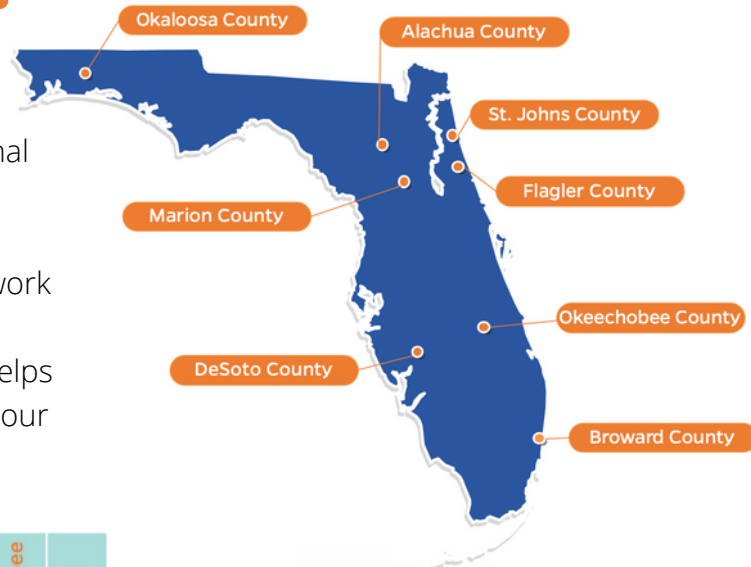

Our intensive, school-based professional development efforts have focused on deepening teachers' knowledge and enhancing their classroom application of evidence-based instructional methods. In addition to our work with teachers, we also support the development of literacy coaches, district leaders, and school administrators. This helps school districts build capacity and create systems in which our teacher development work can thrive.



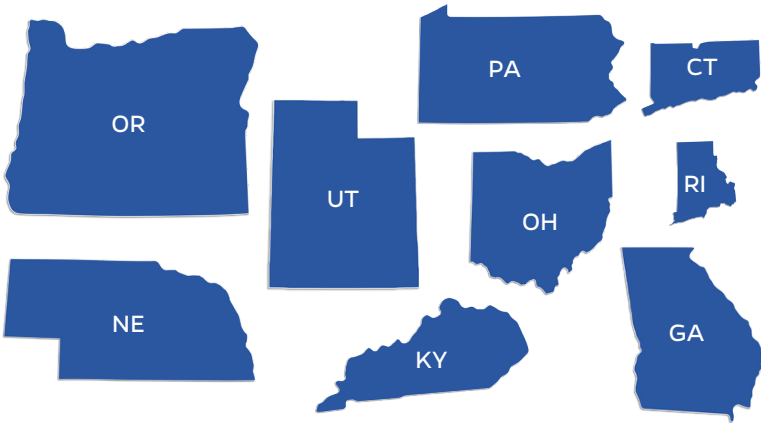

The impact of UFLI extends well beyond the state's borders. The UFLI Virtual Teaching Resource Hub, which we developed to support our partner schools as they shifted to remote teaching during the pandemic, has become the go-to resource for teachers everywhere.
